Elgin Recycling:

Office Equipment: Scanners / Fax Machines, Printers, Toner/Ink Cartridges, Copy Machines, Desktop Fax Machines, rechargeable batteries

Electronic Equipment: TVs, Stereos, Radios, Gaming Consoles, VCRs, Tape & CD Players

Computers: Desktop, Laptop, Mainframes, Servers

Computer Monitors: any type

Computer Accessories: Keyboards/Mice, Peripherals, Power & Network Cables, Modems, Hard Drives, CD-Roms, UPS (personal & network)

Extension and Power Cords, VHS Tapes, CDs, Telephones / Cell Phones
