- Crt, Flat Screens, Projection TVs and Monitors:
- Under 21 inch screen = \$25.00 per unit
- 21 inch screen and over = \$35.00 per unit
- **Electronics FREE** VCRs, DVD players, cameras, computers/laptops, copiers, electronic keyboards, microwaves, mice, modems, PDAs, printers, projection devices, audio and video equipment (no video cassettes and discs), scanners, radios, speakers (not wood), stereos, telephones and zip drives, cords/chargers of all sizes.
- American Flags
- **Document Shredding:** 3 boxes or bags per car
- Lead Acid Batteries: car, boat, lawn mower, truck, sump pump, RV and all sport vehicle batteries
- Bicycles or Bicycle Parts
- Books, records, compact disks.
- Clothing, hats, gloves, shoes, boots.
- Domestics: linens, curtains, blankets
- Hand tools and small power tools
- Kitchen goods: utensils, plates, pots/pans.
- Medical Equipment clean and in working condition
- Musical instruments
- Propane Tanks 20# and under
- Scrap metal: old swing sets, fences, posts
- Sports equipment, games, toys
- Other items: ink jet cartridges, cell phones, eye glasses, buttons from clothes, keys, hearing aids
- Window Air Conditioners
- NO Light Bulbs, NO Paint, NO Household Hazardous waste, NO Fire Extinguishers
